

Public Space Protection Order

Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014



DOG FOULING

A person who is in charge of a dog shall be guilty of an offence if they fail to remove the faeces from the land forthwith.



LEADS BY ORDER

A person who is in charge of a dog that is deemed out of control by an authorised officer of the authority shall be guilty of an offence if they do not comply with direction from that officer to put and keep the dog on a lead.



EXCLUSION

A person who is in charge of a dog shall be guilty of an offence if they permit the dog to enter or remain in a fenced / enclosed children's play area or designated marked sport pitch or athletic area.



MEANS TO PICK UP

A person who is in charge of a dog shall be guilty of an offence if they fail to produce an appropriate means to pick up the dog faeces following a request from an authorised officer of the authority.

This order applies to the administrative area of North West Leicestershire District Council.

Failure without reasonable excuse to comply with this Order is a criminal offence and persons may be issued with a Fixed Penalty Notice or fined up to a maximum of £1000 if prosecuted and convicted in the Magistrates Court. CCTV may be in operation.
